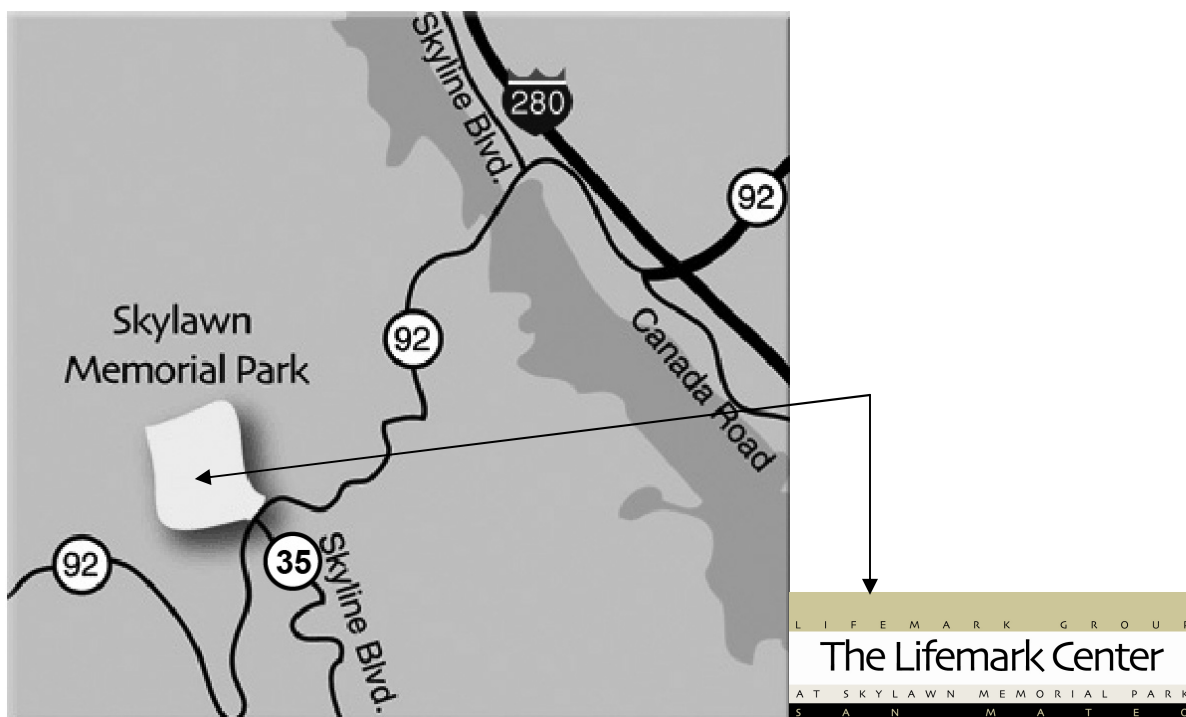

Directions:

From US 101 and I-280, south- and northbound, take Highway 92 west towards Half Moon Bay. Follow the road across Crystal Springs Reservoir, continuing approximately 1.8 miles to the top of hill, just before the intersection of Skyline Boulevard (Highway 35). Skylawn Memorial Park is on the right. Enter the driveway on the right to get to the Lifemark Center. Follow the signs to the visitor's parking lot. Look for "CoDA" signage.
